

1. I appreciate your response, in reference (a), to my request for a determination of the AFC45 daily reimbursement rate for the polar icebreaker. However, I am not sure we are interpreting the language of the MOA in the same manner.
2. In my opinion, the daily maintenance charge should be based on the two vessel average of the AFC45 costs, divided by the employment standard of 185 program days (41 days of Coast Guard use, 144 days for science support).
3. I request you review, once again, the highlighted portions of enclosure (1) dealing with vessel maintenance charges/reimbursements and let me know how you interpret the meaning of the MOA. Also, please let me know what you would consider an appropriate span of time for determining AFC45 averages. I'm inclined towards a 5-year average in order to benefit the financial planning of our customers. I would appreciate your response by 18 November 94.
